# VOSH

---

Volunteer Optometric Services to Humanity, VOSH, is a non-profit organization created in 1984 to provide optometric services to those who are unable to obtain eye care. VOSH is the largest student run organization at EWENCO. In addition to the student volunteers there are licensed optometrist and ophthalmologist who volunteer their services during missions locally and abroad. During the 1988-89 academic year VOSH expanded its role to provide a larger variety and higher quality of services.

In the past it has been customary to provide missions to remote villages in countries such as Mexico and Columbia. During this year, VOSH went to Merida, Mexico and the tropical Rain Forest of Columbia. A total of over 4200 patients were seen. In addition to these missions abroad, a proposal to provide services to the homeless of Boston was accepted after 2 years of negotiations. This program has become so successful that it has been used as a model program for organizations as far away as Vancouver, Washington!

VOSH is also involved in public education. Members of VOSH provide lectures demonstrating the importance of optometric eye care. As a result of these public education lectures, VOSH has been able to maintain its financial independence from government support, while continuing to expand its services to more communities. The organization will continue to thrive thanks to those committed to the program and the community.
