I will advise my patients fully and honestly of all which may serve to restore, maintain or enhance their vision and general health.

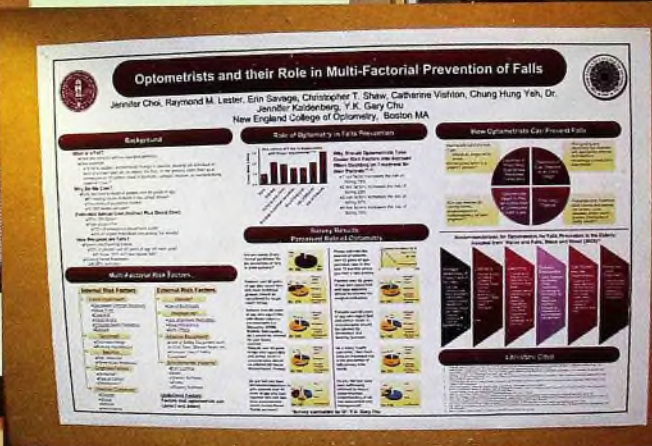
I will strive continuously to broaden my knowledge and skills so that my patients may benefit from all new and efficacious means to enhance the care of human vision.

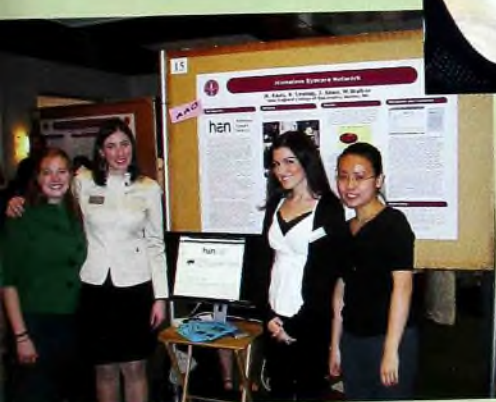

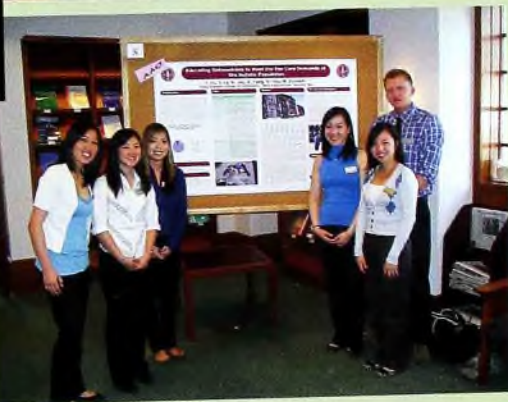

# CLUBS AND ORGANIZATIONS



## American Academy of Optometry

Mission Statement: The major goal of the American Academy of Optometry is to maintain and enhance excellence in standards of optometric practice. It does this by fostering research and the dissemination of knowledge in both basic and applied vision science.

## American Optometric Student Association (AOSA)

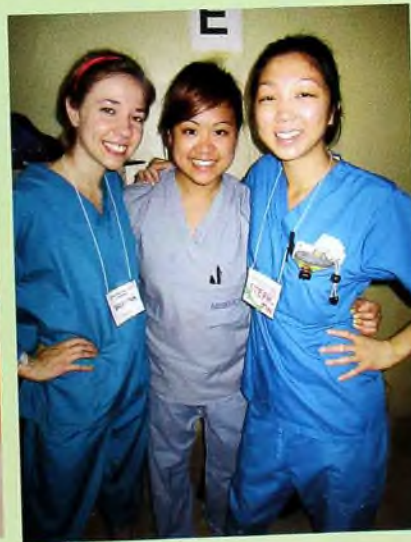


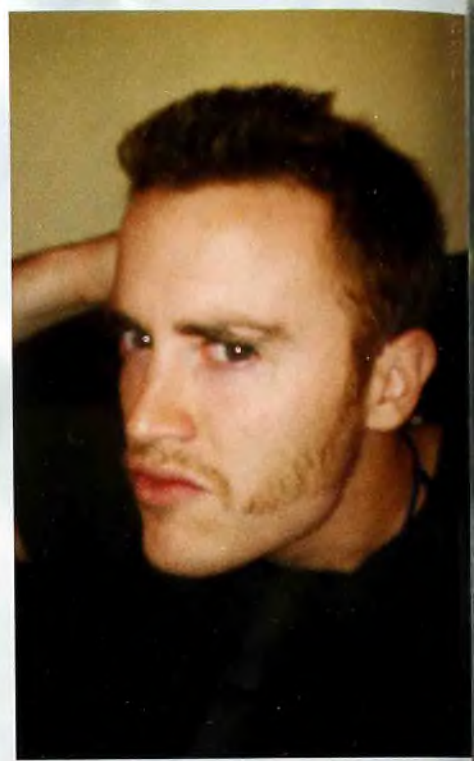
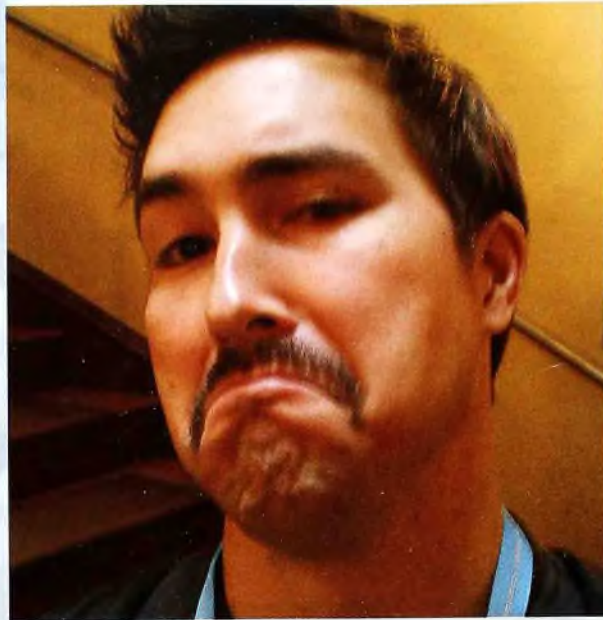

Our class had one of the largest VOSH groups with 20 students participating in our week long international clinic held in Batey San Ingenio Porvenir, Dominican Republic. Despite some difficulty making our way through customs, we were able to examine and provide glasses to over 900 patients as well as make referrals for cataract and other surgeries and provide medications where appropriate. VOSH continues to be an international organization with 35 regional chapters (including some in Canada) waiting for your participation as an OD!
