Dear Friends,

What an eventful four years it has been. We've come a long ways from our first screening, midterm, and proficiency; and soon, we will take complete and sole responsibility for the care of our patients. That is very exciting! Let us give care wherever we are, just as our professors, our preceptors, our school, our family and our role models have cared.

On the last day of my third rotation, I was reminded of an important lesson: our patients are entrusting their precious eyes with us so we can make the diagnoses that affect their ocular and/or systemic health. A healthy 25-year-old female routine patient with no visual complaints and the same low myopic refraction had come in for a comprehensive eye exam. She had a documented history of lattice degeneration, but I was ready to do an undilated exam and send her on her way. My preceptor encouraged me to do a DFE, and there, in the superior temporal retina, was an atrophic hole next to the lattice. Hence my lesson: our patients might not have any symptoms for anything out of the ordinary, but we still need to look carefully for what we've been trained to pick up. This patient could potentially develop a retinal detachment, but thanks to the dilated eye exam, she was able to get preventative treatment and minimize that risk. We are so lucky to be in a profession where what we do on a routine basis makes a huge difference!

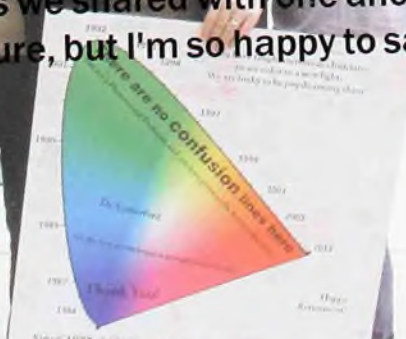


Hello everyone!

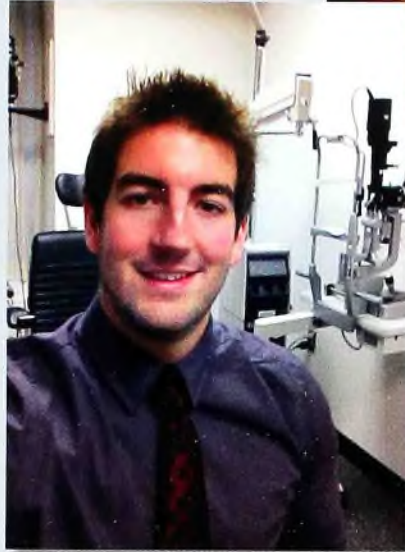
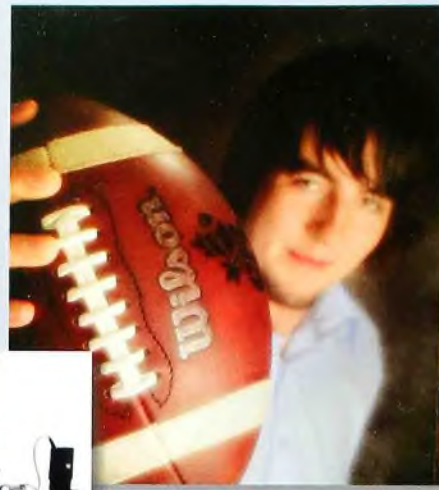

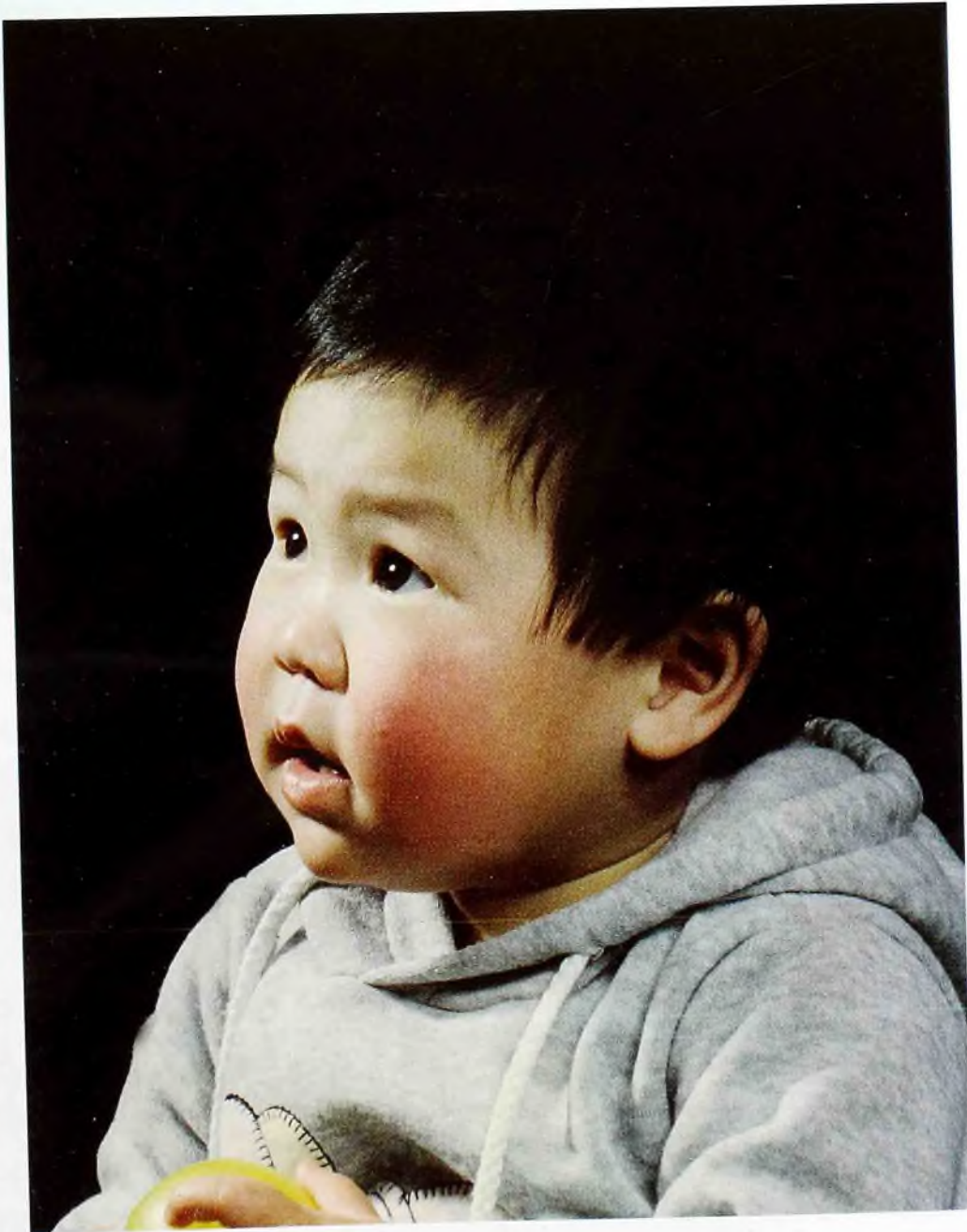
