Letter from President Scott


Dear Members of the Class of 2017:

During the short time that you've been earning your degree at NECO, technical and social changes have dramatically changed your daily life - think: Über, Alexa, and Snapchat. New technologies, as well as social empowerment of patients, payment incentives, and cost containment, will change the health care environment. With much effort, you've achieved a level of clinical expertise that has prepared you to practice in any iteration of eye care that will develop.

For you to maintain professional success, it won't be sufficient to simply react to technologic, regulatory, and policy changes. You will need to pay attention to trends in all these areas. Student Organizations

American Academy of Optometry (AAO)

The AAO works to foster research and dissemination of knowledge in vision sciences. The student branch fosters membership and fellowship in the Academy and promotes optometric research.



American Optometric Association- PAC



The AOA-PAC is the political action committee of the American Optometric Association. The AOA-PAC hosts the annual Congressional Advocacy Conference in Washington, D.C. Students learn about the bill that we need to pass in Congress, and have a day of lobbying on the Hill with experienced optometrists and other optometry students across the nation.

American Optometric Student Association (AOSA)

The American Optometric Student Association (AOSA) is the international professional organization run for and by optometric students and is often an initial exposure to organized optometry. The AOSA represents student interests to a variety of organizations including National Board of Examiners in Optometry, International Association of the Board and various sections of American Optometric Association.



Beta Sigma Kappa (BSK)

Beta Sigma Kappa, BSK, is the International Optometric Honor Society Fraternity. It is an elite group of Optometrists and Optometry students whose mission is to stimulate scientific attainment, academic excellence and the ethical practice of optometry, and to promote and provide financial support for worthy research projects relating to vision care and the eyes.



Contact Lens Society

The Contact Lens Society, CLS, at NECO exists to enhance student interest and knowledge of contact lens care and management in efforts to improve patient care. The society will serve to offer academic assistance for contact lens courses and introduce the community to the newest technological advances and contemporary products.

College of Optometrists in Vision Development (COVD)

The College of Optometrists in Vision Development (COVD) is a non-profit organization that seeks to facilitate and supplement education about behavioral and developmental vision care and vision therapy (VT) through presentations and speakers. COVD at NECO promotes education on vision therapy and aims to show students how VT can help patients improve their overall visual abilities and skills, in turn enhancing how they process visual information and improving their visual comfort, ease, and efficiency.



La Vista (Spanish Club)

La Vista is a club designed to try and teach medical Spanish to all faculty, and students at NECO. The club gets together every other week to teach Spanish and converse over lunch. All levels of Spanish conversational ability are welcome!

Lions Club International

The NECO Lions Club is a non-profit organization that gives back to the community by fundraising within the school and donating the proceeds to great causes/charities. The NECO Lions Club is dedicated to the Lions' motto of "We Serve" and volunteer their time and talents towards eye research and the betterment of the community.



Massachusetts Society of Optometrists (MSO)

The Massachusetts Society of Optometrists is dedicated to the fulfillment of quality vision and eye care needs of all the public. To achieve this goal, the MSO seeks to unite all Massachusetts optometrists in their effort to practice the highest standard of care through support of continuing education and research.

Neuro-Optometry Rehabilitation Association (NORA)



This Association is committed to advancing treatment of the neurologically impaired patient. At NECO, members of this club provide tutoring and support for other students taking a Neuroanatomy course as well as bringing speakers to the college to share their experiences.



National Optometric Student Association (NOSA)

The National Optometric Student Association (NOSA) promotes the delivery of vision care to minority communities through consumer education, legislative advocacy and minority recruitment and retention activities. The Association informs minority community members about vision protection, and works to raise legislators' awareness of minority consumers' visual needs.

Public Health Club (PHC)

The Public Health Club (PHC) helps bring awareness to the student body on topics outside of optometry, whether that be related to the specific workings of government or other areas of healthcare. The executive council of the PHC serves as liaisons of the American Public Health Association.

Private Practice Club (PPC)

The Private Practice Club (PPC) strives to cultivate the future's leaders in optometry by providing business management education and insights into the world of private practice to students. In doing so, students will be more prepared for the obstacles and challenges of private practice. 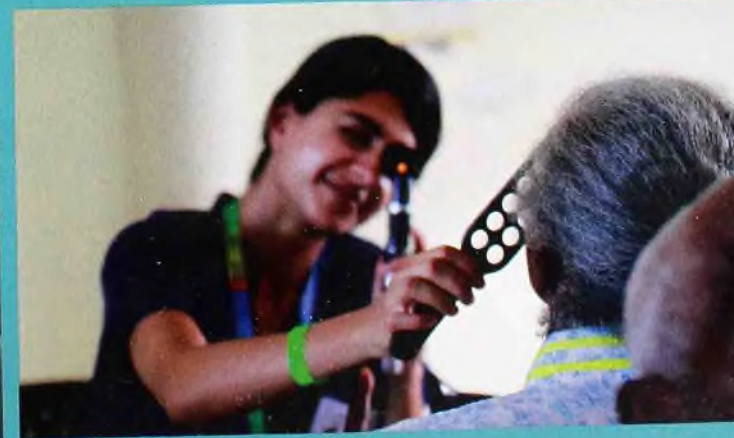

SVOSH-NECO Trip 2016

SVOSH-NECO's mission is to provide eye and vision care to the underserved population who cannot afford or lack access to care. Student clinicians, along with practicing optometrists, travel to underserved populations in countries, usually within the Latin American region. On these missions, every patient seen receives a basic eye care examination, and is given a pair of prescription eyeglasses for vision correction, sunglasses and/or eye medications when required. Referrals are made for further treatment such as cataract surgery.

One international mission is planned in the Spring Term each year. In April 2016, SVOSH-NECO went to Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.
